I looked at all chapters in the Bible of 22-25, as well as verses 22-25 from any chapter “20” for the years 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025. I’ll let you look over the Bible notes below for each year. But there was lots in 22 about death/ Needing Prophecy and protection; 23 about food lacks, supply and wilderness for God’s people; worshipping AC; 24 longing to see Jesus, finishing the course, two witnesses, prophesying, Jesus coming soon and preparing for it, more people numbering and idol worship, more wilderness hiding and miracles; 25 Wife and wedding, salvation of the Lord, New Jerusalem, seeing the Lord, wrath of God and Armageddon battle.

Although I didn’t do chapters 21 too much, it was interesting that Leviticus 21 is about being holy, undefiled, and also separation into classes of “clean and unclean”—like the evil phax is doing, segregation due to health.
